



TRAINING WORKSHOPS

The training workshops for Digitalized Creativity Boost Training for Migrants took place in 5 countries, Cyprus, Slovakia, Poland, Spain and Italy in their host communities on February, 2023.

The pilot workshops, were organised with at least 20 migrants per country. Participants engaged in a variety of sessions and activities that amounted to 12 hours of face-to-face interaction and used Open Educational Resources (OER) for accessing the e-learning material. The Online Linguistic Support (OLS) presented to the participants, encouraged them to explore further the utilisation of platforms which offered free online language courses.
